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WHAT ARE WORK ETHICS?

- Ethics are moral principles that govern a person's behaviour or the conducting of an activity
- Work ethics are a set of moral principles or values that an employee abides by and uses in their job performance. It covers an employee's behavior and attitude towards their job, career, and the workplace.
- Work ethic can either be strong (good) or weak (bad), depending on an employee's motivation, personal beliefs, and the culture of the entire organisation.

TYPES OF WORK ETHICS



Strong

- This is a way of thinking that an employee brings to their work and shows they are very passionate about what they do.



Weak

- A lack of ambition and professionalism in the workplace is exhibited by an employee who has a poor work ethic.

Highly disciplined employees show determination and commitment to the job. They strive to meet or exceed expectations and seek opportunities to learn new skills and improve their performance.

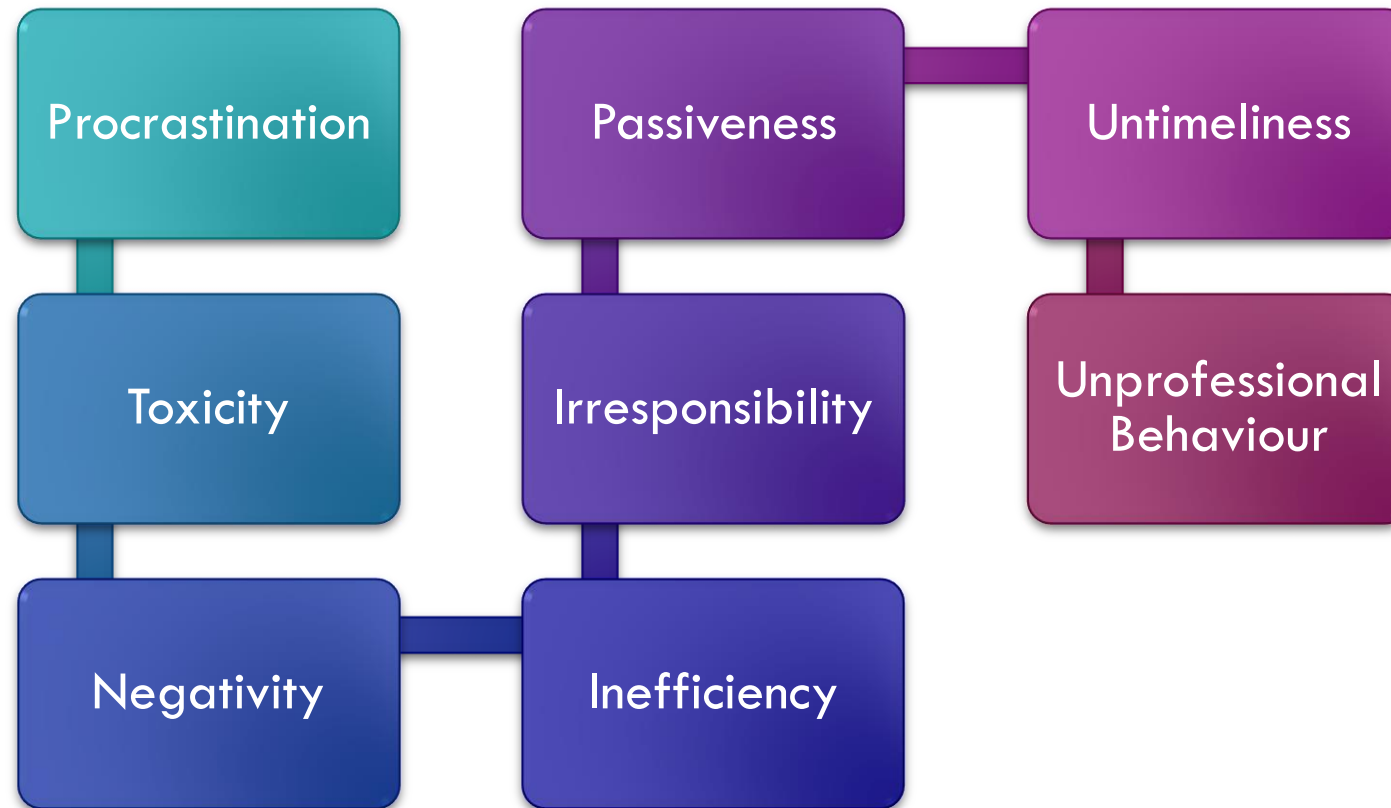
Productivity
